The annual event **Exploration in the House – New data, new exploration futures** presented by the Department of Regional NSW's Mining, Exploration and Geoscience will showcase the latest projects and new geoscience and geophysical data from the Geological Survey of NSW.

Chief Geoscientist and Head of the Geological Survey of NSW, Phillip Blevin said "We are pleased to bring our annual showcase event back again in 2024, aligning with NSW Minerals Week."
