

Leadville Mine Remediation Program

May 2025

The NSW Government has completed remediation work at the historic Leadville Mine in the state’s Central West.

What has been done?

Remediation work has been completed to help improve safety and reduce environmental impacts from historic mining activity.

Key sources of contamination have either been removed or impacts minimised through drainage diversions. Residual contamination has been fenced off to manage potential exposure.

The work involved:

- excavating key areas of contaminated soil, which has been backfilled with clean onsite material
- fencing
- drainage improvements to control surface water and improve longevity of the remediation work
- revegetation of final landforms, including residual contamination area
