Need to update Schedule 10; Clause 20; "Electrical Engineer" as it currently says that the function is to "develop and review" the standards and procedures. The statutory functions for Mining Engineering Manager and the Electrical Engineering Manager say "develop, supervise, monitor and review". The Electrical Engineering Control Plan code of practice also says that "develop, supervise, monitor and review" applies to all mining operations. Schedule 10; Clause 20 Electrical Engineer should read "develop, supervise, monitor and review the standards and procedures". This has also been discussed within the Electrical Engineers Certificate of Competency panel and has had support.
